The End Semester Examinations have been conducted through Proctored Online Mode in our college in association with e-NOVA Software Solutions, Coimbatore. It enhances the perception of the students' thirst for education and broadens their horizons in the challenging and changing world. It also helps the Institution to maintain the quality of its educational Programmes.

3. The Context

Educational Systems and Methodology are growing at a rapid rate. Simultaneously, the quality of Education is nurtured in the institution by conducting examinations during the lockdown period. The conduction of End Semester Examinations simplifies through the system which was adopted in the college for carrying out the activities of the examination. An online proctored examination enhances the quality of education.

4. The Practice

The best Practices in this system are listed below

- Username and Password for the mock examination and End Semester Examination shared to the students' through their official email. Once a user logs into the system with Username and Password, it takes the students to take a photograph with their details. If the student does not give access to any of these, the student cannot be able to appear for the examination or the remote proctor can disable the examination in due course of time.
- The system uses Artificial intelligence (AI) to detect and record face emotions, eye movements and all activities, without any hindrance to the examinations.
- In addition to auto proctoring by the online examination system, Manual Proctors (Invigilators) continuously watch and monitor the students during the entire duration of the examination.
- The proctor with the help of the system can issue regular warnings on the screen of the student device. The examination is auto submitted after the completion of the total duration of the examination However; students facing any technical issue during the examination can continue upto 15 minutes after the scheduled session time.
- All the actions were closely monitored by the remote proctors during the examination.
- All the Activities were automatically recorded

of the student taking the examination with the facial photo captured initially for any
mismatch. In case of any mismatch, the system captures the anomaly and a notification
to the student / live proctor was also instantly displayed.

Sit in front of your Webcam. Your photo will be auto captured after 5 seconds timer. In case photo is not captured properly, you can re-click photo by clicking the button "Click Again" as shown below. *This step is very important as your photo will use for verification purpose at the time of admission*.



If your face is not clear in the clicked image, it will give an error "Face not detected" and you have click again.

Once your photo is captured properly, click on "Start test" button.







- Charge the laptop or mobile well in advance to last for at least 2 hours.
- Student to be seated using a wall as the background.
- Ensure proper lighting in the room so that the pictures captured during the exam are not blurred.
- Photograph clicked must of good quality.
- Check the power plugs.
- You should ensure proper internet connectivity is available on your laptop/ desktop/mobile.
- You must make sure webcam and mic of your system is working properly.
- After setting up audio setup with the help of headphones or earphones, you don't need to plug them in ears, you can put them on the keyboard or on the table.
- You will be under constant observation during the entire duration of the test via artificial intelligence tools and live monitoring by the proctors.
- Blank sheets are allowed for the rough work.
- Any suspected activity will lead to the immediate termination of the exam. The room must be as quiet as possible.
- You should have your water bottle at your table before start of exam as you are not allowed to leave the test screen during exam.



- Do not share your passkey with anyone.
- Do not try to navigate from the main screen.
 Doing so will automatically terminate your exam.
- You are not allowed to talk to anyone while your exam is being conducted, as Real Time Monitoring is being done.
- You are not allowed to use device other than the one used for the exam, electronic gadgets or any other material on the day of exam. If found then it will be considered for the cancellation of your exam by the Proctor.
- Do not move away from the frame being captured by the camera.
- Do not try to cover your camera or unplug the external camera from the system.
- You are not allowed to touch the key board while you are attempting your test, you are only allowed to scroll cursor or with mouse to answer the question.
- Use a single device for the exam. Login from multiple device can lead to cancellation of your exam.
- There should be no disturbance in the surroundings.
- Reading questions loudly or talking are not permitted.
- You must not plugged in headphones, ear buds, or any other type of listening equipment.
- You must not leave the room for any reason during exam.
- You must not communicate with any person by any means during the exam.
- Sounds such as music or television are not permitted.
