



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### II. MINUTES OF THE MEETING

The Sixth Academic Council meeting was held on 28.12.2022 with the presence of all the Academic Council members at 11.00 a.m. with the approval of Centre for Academic Courses, Anna University, Chennai (CAC Letter No: Lr.No. 5126/AU/CAC/2022, Dt:28.10.2022) as in Annexure I.

The Principal Dr.R.Satishkumar, Chairman of the Academic Council, Sengunthar Engineering College (Autonomous) welcomed all the members. Then, the proceedings of the meeting were continued by Dr.K.L.Palanisamy, Member Secretary, Academic Council and he reported the Action Taken on the Minutes of the previous Academic Council meeting. Later, he outlined briefly the various agenda points to be presented at the meeting. After a brief discussion, the following agenda points are considered and resolved by the Academic Council.

Item 6.1 To confirm the minutes of the Previous (Fifth) Academic Council meeting held on 13.05.2022.

Item 6.6 To ratify the introduction of new courses result of Merging of Institutions: Sengunthar College of Engineering with Sengunthar Engineering College.

The academic council verified all the approval letters received from AICTE and Anna University, Chennai, as in **Annexure V** for the merger of Sengunthar College of Engineering (2629) with Sengunthar Engineering College (2617) from the academic year 2022-2023 in which **the first year students come under Autonomous** and II, III and IV year students of Sengunthar College of Engineering (2629) are under Anna University, Chennai, non-autonomous category.

Item 6.7 To discuss and approve the Curriculum and Syllabi for the courses B.E. / M.E-Medical Electronics, B.E.- Robotics and Automation, B.Tech.- Information Technology and B.Tech.- Artificial Intelligence and Data Science.

The Academic Council reviewed the whole minutes of the Board of Studies Meeting of the Department concerned and Resolved to approve the Curriculum and Syllabi for the courses B.E. / M.E. –Medical Electronics,





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B.E.Robotics and Automation, B.Tech. Information Technology and B.Tech. Artificial Intelligence and Data Science as in **Annexure VI**.

Item 6.8 To discuss and approve the Revised Guidelines and norms in the Regulations of 2019 (Revised) under the category of Minor and Honours Degree courses.

Resolved to approve the Revised Guidelines and norms in the Regulations of 2019 (Revised) under the category of Minor Degree and Honours courses as in Annexure VII.

Besides, the Academic Council suggested the following points:

- 50 % of the syllabus should be taught by the Industrial experts which would be attended by the faculty members to gain more expertise in the specialization concerned.
- ii) Made MoU with leading Industries and practical exposure should be given to the students based on their domain.
- iii) Faculty members should visit Industry and a video of the functioning of the Industry should be shared with the students.
- Item 6.9 To discuss and approve the NCC Army course as an open elective course.

**Resolved to approve** the NCC Army course as an open elective course to the NCC Army cadets' alike NCC Air force.


Item 6.10 To discuss and approve to conduct special exams, if required, in an alternate schedule for NCC (Air wing and Army) and Sports students (Zonal / University / State / National Level).

After detailed deliberation, the conduction of special exams provision was approved in principle by the Academic Council. When the need arises, with





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the proper approval from the competent authorities it can be conducted hardly.

Item 6.11 Any other matter brought forward by the Chairman and the members of the Academic Council.

# Points suggested by the Academic Council Members :

- Engineering students should be trained as genius in their domain and train them for the demands of large and complex projects, and the need for socially responsible multidisciplinary innovation.
- Students must be skilled in basic engineering principles and practices, be trained to think analytically, learn how to communicate effectively, and work in multidisciplinary teams.

## The following points to be included in the Regulations 2023:

- 1. The Academic Council suggested for introducing two unique courses, Tamizharum Thozhilnutpamum (Tamils and Technology) and Tamizhar Marabu (Heritage of Tamils) as per the direction of Anna University, Chennai. Both these courses are mandatory for all engineering students with Tamizharum Thozhilnutpamum being taught during the first semester and Tamizhar Marabu during the second semester. The course material for the two subjects can be given in both Tamil and English languages. The students can write the exams either in Tamil or English language.
- Students should be encouraged to do more Value added courses. These courses can be added with CGPA to the maximum permissible credits and the remaining will be mentioned in the mark sheet.
- If the student failed to complete his/her Minor Degree / Honours then the subjects passed by him/her may be mentioned in the Mark sheet.





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 Syllabus and Curriculum shall be formulated to cover the syllabus of the Engineering / Public service Competitive Examinations of the faculty Concerned.

The Chairman summarized the various decisions taken by the Academic Council and Dr.B.Sujatha, Dean / Academics thanked all the members for their active participation and valuable suggestions on various points discussed in the meeting.

The Meeting was concluded by 1.30 p.m.
